

Claire Coeshott, PhD, Named Immunology Laboratory Director, Advanced Diagnostic Laboratories at National Jewish Health

Dr. Coeshott comes to National Jewish Health with more than two decades of laboratory and research experience in the fields of immunology and immunotherapy. Most recently, she worked at Terumo Blood and Cell Technologies in Lakewood, Colo., where she served as a Senior Scientist. Previously, Dr. Coeshott also served as Director of Immunology for Globelmmune, INC, and Director of Biology for RxKinetix, INC.
